Co-Owner, Lab Coat Innovations, LLC - Jan. 2007 - Feb. 2008

I owned a residential painting company during my college years (not listed) as my first entrepreneurial venture. Drawing from that experience, a former manager and I developed and began marketing a software program to enable physicians to collect and manage patient outcomes. The enterprise was self funded and we both underestimated the capital requirements to make the company successful. We did manage a few beta customers and one multi center (international) clinical trial which I personally monitored. This was a valuable entrepreneurial experience that I am grateful for.

Research Coordinator, Oregon Brain and Spine Institute, 2004 - 2006

Promoted from my billing specialist job, I was recruited to start the research department. I obtained over \$100,000 in grant funding in two years. Realizing a need for efficiency, I also wrote an electronic data capture system from scratch. I became very experienced in most aspects of clinical research: grant writing, contract negotiation, protocol development, IRB compliance and statistical analysis. The practice was comfortable presenting me with new challenges and I regularly delivered strong results.

As a requirement of my master's degree, I spent about six months with the volunteer department helping to identify and execute operating efficiencies. In addition, we built an environment of collaboration among on and off duty volunteers. I also designed a new system of recruiting high school students reducing hospital staff time in recruiting and scheduling.
